

What is Data Literacy?

The ability to read data, work with data, and communicate about data by putting it in proper context.

Using Data as foundational in supporting all Business Activities

- Data is available and actionable by all business users
- Data supports and drives business decisions

It includes understanding:

- How to assess data sources and collection methods
 - Data definitions
 - Data lineage
 - Data quality

Responsible Data Use:

- Contractual
- Appropriateness
 - Classification and PII
 - The value of working with understanding data
 - Telling the Story
 - Quantifying the value or ROI





Data Literacy: Closing the Gap



Enterprise-wide data literacy is low:

24% of business decision makers surveyed are fully confident in their ability to read, work with, analyze, and dispute data.



Senior leaders do not display confidence:

32% of the C-suite is viewed as data

literate, potentially holding senior leaders back from encouraging their workforces to use data to their advantage.



Future employees are underprepared for data-driven workplaces:

21% of 16-to 24-year-olds are data literate,

suggesting schools and universities are failing to ensure students have the skills they need to enter the working world.



Organizations are losing competitive advantage because better data literacy drives higher enterprise performance:

85% of data-literate people say they are performing very well at work, compared to 54% of the wider workforce.



Data is key to professional credibility:

94% of respondents using data in their current role agree data helps them do their jobs better, and they also believe greater data literacy would give them more credibility (82%) in the workplace.



There is an appetite to learn:

78% of business decision makers said they would be willing to invest more time and energy into improving their data skill sets.

For the insurance industry – How it is being used in practice

Adoption of More Robust Data Governance Programs

- **Data Cataloging** sources, definitions, ownership, stewardship
- **Data lineage** where does the data go what applications, which users
- **Data quality** Publishing "Fit for Purpose" quality metrics
- Data Use
 - Contractual
 - Customers and Vendors
 - Appropriateness
 - Understanding the source allows you to use the best, or understand nuances in the data
 - Classification and PII

Data literacy is for EVERYONE

Not limited to Analysts and Developers (Quants and Programmers)

Executives are held responsible, and are using the data to "tell the story" and drive corporate direction



For the insurance industry – How it is being used in practice

• Collaboration – *Finally breaking down the data silos*

Environments for data sharing

- Are we finally out of the mainframe world / To the Cloud?
- Shared information for Data Exploration

Data in the hands of all users

- Self Serve
- Less reliance on someone else to "fetch" the data

- Storytelling with Pictures
- More meaningful analysis
- Available to a greater audience





- **62%** of Council members using frameworks use DCAM


WHAT'S IN DCAM?

- Includes: Data Supply Chain, Advanced Analytics, Data Ethics and Responsible AI/ML




