

Hype cycle to plateau of practicality












In contrast, traditional AI has been used to classify and recognize patterns in existing data.

Uniqueness of Generative AI is resulting in new attack vectors that target sensitive data




Large Language Models easily "memorize" Info, making AI Data Risk Management a key consideration




